PREFACE

Jamaica conducted its Fourteenth Census of Population and Housing in 2011. Under the provisions of the Statistics Act, the Statistical Institute of Jamaica (STATIN) is vested with the authority to conduct any census in Jamaica. The census plays an essential role in all elements of the national statistical system, including the economic and social components. Census statistics are used as benchmarks for statistical compilation or as a sampling frame for household sample surveys. The national statistical system of almost every country relies on sample surveys for efficient and reliable data collection. Without the sampling frame derived from the population and housing census, the national statistical system would face difficulties in providing current reliable official statistics.

While recognizing the importance of the census however, countries are faced with serious resource constraints. Census taking in Jamaica faces not only the challenge of limited resources but an apathetic public which views official data collection with suspicion and even hostility. Despite a vibrant publicity programme for Census 2011, the level of cooperation particularly in some urban centres was disappointing. Worker attitude also presented problems as in a number of cases workers had to be relieved of their duties due to poor and or unproductive work. There was not always sufficient recognition of the fact that remuneration was for work done.

The processing of the census returns is a massive undertaking for which STATIN sought to utilize modern technology for this phase. The data processing of the questionnaires was out-sourced to XSOMO International Ltd., who was required to produce the electronic data in a database format and images of the questionnaires. Scanning of the forms which began in June 2011 ended on January 31, 2012. The data editing and cleaning were done using software developed internally and shared via the intranet. The validity and consistency checks which follow will continue until a full and clean database is produced. As the process continues, reports on those topics for which checks are completed, will be produced. At a later date, The Statistical Institute will entertain requests for unpublished data according to stipulated procedures and conditions.

This report is one in the series of subject reports which will provide tabulations based on the specific topics covered on the census questionnaire, at varying geographic levels. This report presents tabulations on Place of Birth, Parish of Residence as well as International and Internal Migration. Tabulations are presented at the parish level.

Among the reports to be published is a separate report for each parish which brings together tables on all topics in one volume.

BACKGROUND TO THE CENSUS

Legal Authority for the Census

The 2011 Population and Housing Census was taken under the provisions of the Statistics (Amendment) Act 1984. In accordance with Section 4 of the Statistics Act, the House of Representatives approved the Census Order, 2011 on January 5, 2011. This Order authorized the taking of a Population and Housing Census in Jamaica between April 5 and December 31, 2011. Also, under Section 6 of the Act, the Minister of Finance and Planning made the Census Regulations, 2011 on January 5, 2011. These Regulations outlined the conditions under which the census was to be conducted.

Coverage, Design and Methodology

Censuses of population are generally conducted on either a 'de facto' or 'de jure' basis. A 'de facto' census seeks to determine the number and characteristics of the population present in an area at the time of the census. The 'de jure' census identifies the population usually resident in the area whether physically present or not, at the time of the census. The 2011 census, like all since 1943, was conducted on a 'de jure' basis. The 'de jure' count includes all persons, Jamaicans and non-Jamaicans whose usual place of residence was in Jamaica even if they were temporarily (less than six months) abroad at the time of the census.

The following groups were excluded:

- (i) All Jamaicans (including diplomatic personnel) who were away from the country for six months or more;
- (ii) All visitors to Jamaica who are usual residents of other countries; and
- (iii) All foreign diplomatic personnel located in Jamaica.

One questionnaire was developed for use in the census to collect information from households (Appendix II – Form PC011A) and one for individuals (Appendix III – Form PC011B). The data collecting method utilised was the "Interviewer Method". One census taker was assigned to each enumeration district (the smallest census geographic area) to list every building in the area assigned. Where the building was found to be the living quarters of an individual or a group of individuals the form was completed for each household and each person. Each census taker worked with a household form and an individual form. Consideration was also given to the enumeration of persons who live in institutions as well as persons who were located on the streets and this was taken into account in the design.

The census design also included a Post Enumeration Survey planned as a coverage assessment tool. The Post Enumeration Survey was conducted during

the period September 7-30, 2011 in all parishes and covered a 5 per cent sample of census EDs. A total of 286 EDs were eventually canvassed.

The Institutional Population

All institutions, which could be regarded as the usual residence of the inhabitants either because they had no other residence or because they were 'long-term' residents, were included. General hospitals, public and private were therefore generally excluded. The treatment of the institutional population as regards the questions asked was determined by the accessibility of the persons resident to the interviewer. Where no access was possible, only age and sex data were retrieved from administrative records. Where access was possible, the entire individual questionnaire was administered. Trainees and students of all educational institutions were canvassed with the individual questionnaire.

If an institution contained separate quarters for staff members, caretakers, etc., these quarters were treated as private dwellings.

Types of Institutions

- (i) Convents and Monasteries
- (ii) University and College Residences
- (iii) Hostels and Residences for Trainees and/or Graduate Teachers, Nurses and Ministers of Religion
- (iv) Military Camps, Police Training Schools and Police Barracks
- (v) Boarding Schools and Other Residential Schools
- (vi) Correctional Institutions, Penitentiaries, Prisons, Rehab Centres, Juvenile Institutions
- (vii) Mental Institutions
- (viii) Homes for Children/Aged/Infirm/Needy
- (ix) Hospitals and Homes providing specialized care
- (x) Hospitals and Homes for the Blind, Deaf and Other Handicapped

Persons on the Streets

This group comprises persons who may or may not be usual residents of a private or non-private dwelling. Area Managers were instructed to familiarise themselves with the locations where such persons tend to frequent for purposes of sleeping, and obtain as much information as possible. Locations included bus parks, markets, drains and sidewalks. Some persons were also identified by charity organizations which provide daily meals for such persons.

The Scope of the Census

The United Nations Principles and Recommendations guided all technical considerations including the choice of topics. The topics included on the census questionnaire were as follows:

Geographic Division of Jamaica for Census Purposes

Jamaica was divided into 5,776 geographic units called enumeration districts (EDs) for the purpose of data collection during the 2011 Population and Housing Census (see Appendix I). Each ED is an independent unit which shares common boundaries with contiguous EDs. The number of dwellings/households contained in the ED (estimated before the census) was the primary determination

of the size of an ED. This was approximately 150 dwellings/households in urban areas and 100 in rural areas. Each ED was designed to be of a size that would ensure an equitable work load for each census taker, and because dwellings are more widely spaced in rural areas than in urban areas, rural EDs usually contained fewer dwellings/households than their urban counterpart. When grouped together, enumeration districts reconstitute larger divisions; special area, constituency and the parish.

Field Organization

For administrative purposes the island was divided into 7 Regions, 62 Coordinator Areas and 1,029 Supervisory Zones. A central Census Office was established in the Kingston Metropolitan Area (KMA). Seven Regional Managers who were selected from STATIN's permanent field supervisors operated from offices in the KMA, Linstead, May Pen, Black River and Montego Bay. Each of the 62 Area Coordinators maintained an office in a central location in the area. The field organization operated under the direction of the Director of Field Services.

Field Enumeration

Field enumeration started slowly on April 5, 2011 as many Census Takers had not been issued identification cards. For an identification card to be issued, the Area Coordinator must have completed the selection process and submit the relevant information to the head office where checks had to be made to verify the training location of the individual. Photographs for identification were stored by training sites so this information had to be retrieved to request the identification from the service providers.

The collection process limped for the first three weeks of April and returns were slow. Census takers began to express dissatisfaction with what they considered late payments of Training Fees. By the beginning of May with such payments made, the pace of enumeration picked up somewhat but census workers again began agitating for payments of claims for travelling even in some instances with very little or no work done. The militancy continued as the problems with these first payments were resolved very close to the pay period. Some persons threatened to leave the job. At this time members of the senior staff of STATIN were kept busy responding to the media as they were approached by dissatisfied census workers.

A number of supervisors and census takers gave up the job while others were relieved because of non-performance but by the time that began to happen, there were persons available as replacements. The data collection phase ended on August 31, 2011.

Challenges of Data Collection

The main challenges encountered could be summarized in the following-

- the general hostility of the population with what was regarded as a 'government' project;
- the inability to relate their participation with immediate personal benefits;
- the belief that the information would be given to the tax collectors;
- violence in some areas and the inability to be out late at nights;
- incidents of dog bites;
- lack of access to gated communities;
- inefficient and unproductive census workers.

Birthplace, Residence and Migration in the 2011 Census

Introduction

The topics of Birthplace, Residence and Migration are considered together because of the close interrelationship between them. Birthplace may be a foreign country or an administrative division within the country. Data on the foreign born serve as indicators of international migration while for the local born the data are used in the measurement of internal mobility. International Migration is the movement across national boundaries. It is designated as emigration from the standpoint of the nation from which the movement occurs and immigration from that of the receiving nation. Internal migration refers to migration within the boundaries of a given nation. For many countries the study of internal migration is based on census questions relating to place of birth, place of previous place of residence, duration of residence in place of enumeration and place of residence on a specific date before the census.

Place of birth has traditionally been included in national censuses. The first national census to contain such an item was that of England and Wales in 1841. This has much relevance for Caribbean Censuses as the first censuses of the region conducted between 1841 and 1844 were patterned after the British censuses. The report of the second census of Jamaica conducted in 1861 produced a breakdown by country of birth in great detail, giving eighty-five countries. The categories for the modern censuses have been a combination of countries and areas. These appear to have been determined by the findings from the previous censuses which would identify the major countries/areas of origin. The United Kingdom, the United States of America, Countries of the British Commonwealth including specific Caribbean states, China and the non-English speaking countries of Cuba and Panama have been listed on questionnaires over the years. For 2011 the question was not pre-coded. Instead the country name was written in and assigned a code based on the United Nations Standard Country or Area Codes.

For the local born population the parish is the administrative unit and parish of birth refers to the parish of usual residence of the mother at the time of the birth, which may or may not be the parish where the event actually took place. An important feature of the first modern census of Jamaica, that of 1943, was the introduction of questions designed to capture information which could be used for the study of internal migration. All subsequent censuses have included such questions. The specific questions relate to parish of birth, current parish of residence, previous parish of residence and year of entry into parish of residence

at the census date. The concept of migration involves a change of parish of residence and a migration is operationally defined as a change of residence from one parish to another. The fourteen parishes as they existed in 2011 were established by law in 1867 thereby indicating the stability of the boundaries for more than a century.

Section 4 of the Individual Questionnaire shown at Appendix III contained the questions relevant to Birthplace, Residence and Migration. The two main groups of persons to be identified on the basis of their place of birth were the foreign born and the local born. A third group, returning overseas migrants, may be either foreign born or local born. For census 2011, a returning overseas migrant was defined as any resident of Jamaica who had lived overseas for one year or more continuously.

Explanation of Categories

Foreign Born

A resident of Jamaica (at the time of the census) who was born in another country.

Year of Immigration

This was relevant to the foreign born only and refers to the year when the person *first* came to live in Jamaica.

Returning Overseas Migrant

Any resident of Jamaica (local or foreign born), and who (at the time of the census) had lived overseas for one year or more continuously.

Year of Return (for Returning Overseas Migrant)

This is the year the persons returned to live in Jamaica permanently from the last country that he/she lived in for one or more years continuously. A foreign born resident might have come to live in Jamaica for the first time in 1960 then left to live abroad for two years returning in 1962. The year 1962 would be recorded.

Local Born or Native Population

A resident of Jamaica (at the time of the census) who was born in Jamaica.

Parish of Birth (for local born population)

For census purposes the parish of birth was the usual parish of residence of the mother at the time of the birth and not the parish of location of the medical facility where the birth occurred. Where a child was born in a foreign country to a woman whose usual place of residence was in Jamaica, the place of birth for that child would be the parish of usual residence in Jamaica. Only if the mother

was resident in the foreign country (i.e. living there for 6 months or more or intending to live abroad for 6 months or more) should the birthplace be regarded as that country.

Year of Entry into Parish

For the census this was relevant to the local born population only and referred to the year when the person came to live in the parish of residence. A distinction was made between persons born in the parish and persons who were not born in the parish. For those who were not born in the parish, *year of entry was the most recent year of entry*. This means that if the person had moved in and out of the parish, it was the most recent year that was scored. If the respondent was born in the parish, and was found in the parish, and had never resided in another parish year of entry was recorded as the year of birth.

Previous Parish of Residence

This was the parish in which the person lived before coming to live in the parish of residence at the time of the census. If the person had never moved from the parish of birth, then the parish of birth was scored. If the persons had only resided abroad and not in another parish in Jamaica, then the parish of birth was scored.

Lifetime Migrant

A person who was not resident in his/her parish of birth at the time of the census.

Non-Migrant

A person who was resident in his/her parish of birth at the time of the census.

In-Migration

Movement into a parish from other parishes within a specified time period (including lifetime).

Out-Migration

Movement out of a parish to other parishes within a specified time period (including lifetime).

Net Migration

The difference between in-migration and out-migration, for a specific parish. If in-migration exceeds out-migration there is a net gain and if out-migration exceeds in-migration there is a net loss.

Findings from the Census

The Foreign Born

The 2011 census found that just less than one per cent, 23,477 of the total population of Jamaica, was foreign born. The number of men was 11,922 slightly more than the 11,555 women. The total represents a decline of 7 per cent over the 2001 count. Table (i) which presents the total foreign born from the censuses of Jamaica since 1881 shows that the foreign born has always been numerically small but in percentage terms in the earlier part of the nineteenth and twentieth centuries was between 2-3 per cent of the total population. By 1960 the foreign born accounted for 1.3 per cent and by 1991 had fallen to below 1 per cent and has maintained this share since that time. It is very important to note that since 2001 foreign diplomatic personnel resident in Jamaica are excluded from the count. Although they were not explicitly excluded before that census, coverage was thought to be well below the count.

Table (ii) shows that the countries of North America (25 per cent), the territories of the Caribbean including the CARICOM states (22 per cent), Europe (18 per cent) and Asia (13 per cent), represented the main areas of origin for the foreign born in 2011.

More than a half (54 per cent) of the foreign born resident in Jamaica at the time of census 2011 arrived since the year 2000 as shown in table (iii). This compares with 14 per cent arriving before 1980.

An examination of the areas of birth of the foreign born based on the period of entry shown in table (iv) reveals interesting changes. Just over 30 per cent of immigrants arriving before 1980 were of European origin. This percentage was reduced by a half to 16 per cent for those arriving in the period since the year 2000. On the other hand the reverse is seen for persons arriving from North America and from Asia. Arrivals from North America which accounted for 9 per cent of the total in the period before 1980 rose considerably to 32 per cent for the period since 2000. In numerical terms the increase was from 280 to 4,017. The percentage share for Asians doubled from 7 per cent to 14 per cent for the period before 1980 to the period since 2000. While the number of immigrants of Caribbean origin (including CARICOM states) doubled from 1,013 in the earlier period to 2,457 in the later period, in percentage terms this was a drop from 32 per cent to 19 per cent.

Returning Overseas Migrants

As defined for the census a returning overseas migrant was any resident of Jamaica (local or foreign born), and who (at the time of the census) had lived overseas for one year or more continuously. This topic was introduced for the first time in 2001, mainly because of the increasing recognition of former residents of Jamaica who had migrated and were returning to reside in Jamaica. Census 2011 counted 141,589 persons who indicated that they had lived abroad for one year or more continuously (table (v)). More than one half (55 per cent) of these persons, 77,952 spent between 1 and 4 years or more abroad. For census 2001, the question was directed to persons who had spent 5 years or more abroad. The count for these persons was 55,589. The 2011 count for persons who had been resident abroad for 5 years or more was 63,637, indicating an increase of 13 per cent in the number of persons who had resided abroad for that length of time.

For 2011, the sex ratio (the number of men per 100 women) of returning overseas migrants was 114 per 100 reflecting considerably more men than women. The number of men was 75,450 or 53 per cent of the total and women numbered 66,139. In terms of age, just over one third (34 per cent) of returning overseas migrants were in the oldest age group, the 60 years and over. Table (vi) which presents the age distribution by sex shows in the first place, a numerically larger number of men than women for each age group up to age 59 years. The excess is highest for the ages between 40 and 49 years where there were about 4,400 more men than women. At ages 60 years and over, the number of women exceeded the number of men by just fewer than 200. In percentage terms overall there was an increasing percentage by age from 7 per cent for the youngest, the under 20 years old, up to 17 per cent for those between 40 and 49 years. There is a drop to 15 per cent for the 50-59 years and then a large increase up to 34 per cent for ages 60 years and over. An examination of the age-sex differentials show that female returning overseas migrants were on average older than their male counterparts with the median age being 50 years compared to 48 years for men.

Six out of every ten returning overseas migrants (64 per cent) returned from the United States (37 per cent) and the United Kingdom (27 per cent) (table vii). Other Caribbean territories comprised 15 per cent while Canada was the country of departure of 18 per cent. The table also presents the median age of the returnees by country. The average age of those returning from the United Kingdom was 62 years, the oldest, followed by Canada 53 years and the United States of America, 49 years. The youngest returning migrants with median age 41 years came from the Caribbean territories and Other Countries.

Table (viii) presents the number of returning migrants by the period of return to Jamaica. Three distinct periods may be identified as, before 1990, 1990-1999 and 2000 and after. The data show the considerable increase in numbers over the period. The number returning before 1990 was about 24,000. This moved to approximately 25,200 in the decade of the 1990s and between the year 2000 and census 2011 the number of returning migrants had risen to about 72,000, a tripling since the earliest period. The table also shows that over time the percentage of returnees from the United States increased from 28 per cent in the period before 1990 to 37 per cent between 1990 and 1999 and to 40 per cent in the period since 2000. Increases were also seen for the return movements from the Caribbean Territories from 11 per cent in the period before 1990 to 18 per cent for the period since 2000. Occurring simultaneously with these increases is the consistent decline in the percentage of returning residents from the United Kingdom. In the period before 1990 returnees from the UK accounted for 40 per cent of the total numbers for that period. By the latest period, the share of the UK was a lower 23 per cent of the total for that period.

The Local Born Population- Internal Migration

The responses to questions on place of birth and place of residence at the time of the census provide the basis for the Birth-Residence Method of studying internal migration. It should be noted however that this method is deficient in a number of ways. The estimates of internal migration derived can only be regarded as minimum as only persons alive at the end of the study period are covered. Movers who died within the period are omitted from the classification altogether. In such a classification, only those persons whose residences at the beginning and end of the period are different are counted as movers and those who returned during the period to their residence at the beginning of the period are classified as non movers.

Lifetime Migration

The total count of the local born population in the selected households at census 2011 was 2,646,121. As discussed previously, the local born population represents the population born in Jamaica and classified as a usual resident of Jamaica at census 2011. Comparison of data on parish of residence and parish of birth is a reflection of the effects over time of long-term patterns of movement within the country for the purpose of changing residence. For the census this movement is measured by the crossing of parish boundaries. The concept of lifetime migration covers migration between birth and a given point; in this case the point is the time the census is conducted. A lifetime migrant is a person whose area of residence at the time of the census is not the area of birth, regardless of any intervening migrations. Table (ix) presents the local born population by parish of birth and the percentage resident outside the birth parish (the lifetime migrants), at census 2011.

The data show that at census 2011, approximately 26 per cent of the local born population lived outside their parish of birth. There were quite considerable variations by parish, with some parishes indicating much higher lifetime mobility compared to others. The parish with the highest percentage of persons born in the parish and living outside the parish was Kingston. About 9 per cent of the local born population reporting parish of birth, a total of 237,232 persons were born in Kingston. At census 2011, 74 per cent of these persons lived in other parishes, making this parish the one which reflected the highest lifetime mobility. No other parish showed such a high percentage of lifetime migrants. The next highest were St Mary (33 per cent) and Trelawny (31 per cent).

Parishes with populations showing the lowest propensity to migrate to other parishes were St Andrew, St Catherine and St James, with only 11 per cent, 16 per cent and 18 per cent of the population born in these parishes, respectively, living in other parishes at the time of the 2011 census.

Out-migration rates provide a useful summary of the extent of the movement between parishes. Table (x) presents rates based on lifetime migration for males and females separately. Not surprisingly, Kingston was the parish with the highest rates for men (733 per 1,000) and women (745 per 1,000). St. Andrew exhibited the lowest rates, 107 per 1,000 for men and 114 per 1,000 for women. The only other parishes with rates of less than 200 were St. Catherine, 165 per 1,000 and 147 per 1,000, for women and men respectively and St. James 188 per

1,000 for women and 165 per 1,000 for men. In all parishes the rates for women exceeded those for men, indicating once again the higher level of mobility among women. The highest rate observed for any of the two sexes in any parish was the 745 per 1,000 for Kingston women.

The propensity to move also varied with age. Table (xi) shows the percentage of each age group living in the parish of birth and the percentage living outside. While only about 9 per cent of those under 10 years old were living in their parish of birth at the time of the census, the percentage increased as age increased. By ages 30-39 years almost one third (33 per cent) of the population was living outside the parish of birth and by age 60 years and over the percentage had jumped to 41 per cent. The sex differentials showed higher percentages among females at all ages with the largest gaps between the sexes at the middle age ranges between 20 and 59 years. At ages 20-29 years, 24 per cent of males were out-migrants compared to 29 per cent of females and at ages 50-59 years, the comparative percentages were 37 per cent for men and 42 per cent for women.

In much the same way as indicators of out-migration show the parishes whose populations have the greatest propensity to migrate, in-migration indicators show the parishes which have been the most attractive to persons moving. The parish with the highest percentage of residents at census 2011, who were born outside the parish was St Catherine where more than one-third (39 per cent) of the resident local born population at census 2011 were born in other parishes (table (xii)). St Andrew followed with 37 per cent, Kingston and St James with 25 per cent each and Manchester with 21 per cent. The position of Kingston is especially interesting as it was the parish with the highest outward mobility. The explanation lies to a large extent in the historical pattern of inter-parish movements dating back to the late nineteenth and early twentieth century. Roberts (1957, 52) states that "Even as early as 1881 there was evidence of

appreciable in-migration into the town [Kingston]..... In-migration became of much greater importance after 1911.” Indications are therefore, that many of the early residents of Kingston would have come from other parishes.

The lifetime in-migration rates for men and women presented in table (xiii) show St Catherine as the parish with the highest rates for men (370 per 1,000) and women (413 per 1,000) and St. Andrew 346 per 1000 for men and 400 per 1000 for women. St Elizabeth was the parish with the lowest in-migration rates, 118 per 1,000 for men and 135 per 1,000 for women. Other parishes with relatively low rates of in-migration were Westmoreland (151 per 1,000 and 141 per 1000) for women and men respectively, and Clarendon and Hanover with overall rates of about 165 per 1,000.

Inter-Parish Movements 2001-2011

Recent inter-parish migration patterns may be examined from the data derived from the questions on the previous (most recent) parish of residence and year of entry into the current parish of residence from that parish. The movements for the intercensal period 2001-2011 are considered. Table (xiv) highlights the changes in the volume of migration in the previous and most recent intercensal periods. The number of local born residents at census 2011 who changed parish of residence between 2001 and 2011 was estimated at 245,865. This reflects an annual movement of 25,850 in the nine and a half years between the two censuses. The pattern of a female dominated movement as indicated by the lifetime mobility was also evident for the recent pattern of movements, with the total movers comprising 111,712 men and 134,153 women.

While females continued to dominate internal migratory shifts, the number of men changing parish of residence between 2001 and 2011, numbered 9,138 almost doubling the number of women moving (4,854). In percentage terms the number of migrant men increased by 9 per cent compared to the 4 per cent increase seen for women.

The relationship between age and lifetime mobility has been discussed. Table (xv) shows the age distribution of the population moving across parish boundaries in the intercensal period 2001-2011. More than one-fifth (28 per cent) of these persons were between the ages of 20 and 29 years. The percentage increased by age from 16 per cent among the youngest to the peak by age 29 years before gradually declining and by age 60 years and over was down to 5 per cent. The pattern was the same for both males and females with the males having slightly higher levels at the youngest ages (38 per cent up to age 19) compared to

33 per cent for the females of similar ages. At the peak age group of 20-29 years the females showed 30 per cent compared to 25 per cent for the males. The drop to the older ages was greater for the women from 30 per cent to 5 per cent compared to the males from 25 per cent to 5 per cent.

Although every parish gained population during the 2001-2011 intercensal period the magnitude of the inter-parish movements varied. All parishes gained and lost migrants to other parishes and most net flows were not large. The net flow is calculated as the difference between the persons going into a parish and the numbers leaving. There is a net gain when the numbers entering from all other parishes exceed the numbers leaving to all other parishes and a net loss when the numbers leaving to all other parishes exceed the number entering from all other parishes. For the period 2001-2011 four parishes showed net gains; St Catherine, St. James, Manchester and Hanover. The largest net gain to any parish was 36,568 to the parish of St Catherine as shown in table (xvi). The net gain to St Catherine from other parishes was far more than the 2,936 for the next largest net gain to any parish, for St James. Manchester continued the position first seen in the previous period, as it saw a net gain of 1,406. The situation with respect to Hanover with a small net gain of 708 is quite inconsistent with the historical pattern where Hanover as one of the smallest parishes has traditionally been a parish of net loss. The largest losses of 32,731 were from Kingston and St Andrew combined. The net losses from the other parishes ranged from 2,152 for Clarendon to a small 293 for Trelawny.

In most cases the largest inflows and outflows between parishes were with the parishes which were adjacent (shared common borders). Table (xviii) shows the adjacent parishes for each of the fourteen parishes. The estimates of net gain or loss shown in table (xvi) are derived from table (xvii) below which presents the number of persons moving between parishes during the period. Table (xvii) shows that about 60 per cent of the movement between parishes during the period 2001-2011 was with the neighbouring parishes.

The most outstanding example is that of Kingston and St Andrew and St Catherine. Kingston and St Andrew lost 69 per cent of its population to adjacent parishes while gaining 63 per cent from these parishes, a net loss of 6 per cent. St Catherine on the other hand experienced a net gain of 10 per cent from adjacent parishes; gaining 84 per cent and losing 74 per cent.
